General Rules

MEMBERSHIP: Morgan Exhibitors

All Canadian Owners & Riders must have valid EC Silver Sport License (A206) and a Provincial Membership (OEF or equivalent) (A203).

OR

Purchase a Single Event Upgrade (A211) for a Bronze Sport License to Silver Sport License.

- CMHA Membership is required for all owners and exhibitors to compete in Morgan division classes.
- All Seniors competing in amateur classes must possess an EC Amateur Card (A902).
- Valid USEF Membership Cards are acceptable for **US citizens only**

MEMBERSHIP: Hackney & Road Horse Exhibitors

- All Exhibitors entering the ring and showing in the Hackney Division must be a current member of Canadian Hackney Society
- All owners, trainers, drivers and exhibitors, including Junior Exhibitors, are required to be members in good standing with the Canadian Road Horse Association to be eligible to collect prize money. Membership to be remitted to the CRHA secretary or treasurer prior to start of show.

Entry Blanks: Must be complete, including signature, addresses, phone numbers, EC, OE/FEQ where applicable and Horse Registration numbers.

Post Entries: All entries received after the entry closing date will be assessed a \$30.00 post entry fee.

Adds: Show Entry: Will be welcomed after the closing date but will incur a post entry fee.

Day of Adds: will be accepted up to the end of the session prior – **NO EXCEPTIONS**

Scratches: Class Scratches: Competitors are asked to notify the show office/ingate if they are unable to go in a class.

Show Scratch: No entry fee will be refunded after the official start of the show for any reason. Before the official start of the show, entry fees will be refunded with the submission of a certified veterinary certificate. For exhibitors from a distance, a veterinary certificate will be accepted if sent to the Secretary postmarked by August 7, 2026. (The Show Secretary would also appreciate a phone call or email if your horse(s) is/are unable to compete). **Stall fees will not be refunded.**

A horse which is deemed unfit for any class as per veterinary certificate will be deemed unfit for ALL classes in the show.

General Rules

Numbers: Payment or open cheque must be received prior to release of numbers.

Prize Money: Prize money will be credited to each horse's account. **Prize cheques will be made payable to the owner** of the entry unless the office is notified to pay to the rider. Cheques will only be issued to those entries whose accounts have been paid in full.

Returned Cheques: A **\$50.00** charge will be assessed on all returned cheques.

Schedule: The show management further reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or combine any class or condition they deem advisable without notification. Every effort will be made to provide as much notification as possible.

Ring Holds: If there is a "HOLD" requested, there will be three minutes given from the time the last horse leaves the ring from the previous class. A "HOLD" must be requested at least two classes before the class affected. Requests for tack holds must be made to and approved by the In-gate official.

Attire: Any person entering the ring (rider/handler/driver/header) must be in suitable attire.

Stripping: Championship classes will NOT be stripped.

Veterinarian/Farrier Services: *Responsibility of payment for services and supplies: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any bills for veterinary, farrier and food services. Any exhibitor not meeting this obligation to the official Show Veterinarian or farrier may be deemed an undesirable exhibitor and entries from that exhibitor may not be accepted at subsequent shows.*

Wash Racks: Horses must be bathed in wash rack areas only, no bathing in barn aisles. The wash rack area is for bathing horses only.

Notice to American Exhibitors: While every effort will be made to assist you in the variances of EC rules over USEF rules, the sole responsibility is entirely the Exhibitor's to be aware of EC rules.

Vehicles: All vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. There is no parking on the roads or in the barn areas at any time. All motorized vehicles including golf carts, scooters, etc. must be operated by **Fully Licensed Drivers Only**.

Helmets: All persons riding over fences anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet. Harnesses must be secured and properly fitted.

Drug Fees: All horses entered in the Morgan Horse division will be subject to an \$8 drug fee payable at time of entry.

Stalls & Campers

STALLS:

Stalls must be booked in writing. Please make sure to check Stall Map upon arrival and use the assigned stalls. **All horse trailers and RV/campers please use South Entrance – 630 Trinity Road.** You are responsible for payment of all stalls ordered. Stalls are available after 10 am 1 day prior to the start of the horse show and all horses/equipment must be removed following the completion of the show. Arrangements must be made prior to show for anyone wishing an earlier to stable overnight on Sunday, August 9th. Indoor stalls are 10 x 10. Shavings may be pre-ordered and will be available for purchase during the show from the Show Secretary. To assist with our planning, we ask that you order and pay for shavings with your entry form.

TRAILERS:

No overnight stabling of horses in trailers will be allowed. Ship in parking is available at a cost of \$50.00.

CAMPERS:

All camper spaces must be reserved in writing using Entry Form. Camper spaces will be assigned by office. Please make sure to check Camper Map upon arrival and park in the assigned spot. Camper space includes 30 amp service. **There is absolutely no gray water drainage allowed on the grounds.** Any exhibitor not abiding by this will be fined and removed from the property. **NO OPEN CAMP FIRES PERMITTED ON PROPERTY.** Pump-outs are available through an off-site company

MORGAN HORSE DIVISION

Equestrian Canada Silver Rated

"The Ontario Show Horse Classic Morgan Horse Division is a sanctioned Silver competition of Equestrian Canada, c/o House of Sport, 2451 Riverside Drive, Ottawa, ON Canada K1H 7X and is governed by the rules of EC. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book." (A602.2)

1. All athletes (riders) and owners must provide proof of valid 2026 EC Sport License and a valid PTSO membership (OE/Cheval Quebec etc.). Proof of membership must be provided prior to competing at all events. All athletes (riders) and owners must be current members in good standing before the competition for points to apply and remain in good standing all year long. As per EC rules, points may not be assigned retroactively.
2. When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached. Coaches from other countries must be in good standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See rules of Equestrian Canada Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments.
3. All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations.
4. Any horse entered in any Morgan class at this competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location as per EC Rule A602.5.
5. Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible and the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, or rider, or horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all the individuals participating in any capacity in the EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any imposed by the competition. Do not participate in the EC sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.
6. Any athlete at an EC sanctioned competition may be selected for human anti-doping as outlined in the Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) and administered by Sport Integrity Canada. Please see EC General Regs Section A-Appendix A1, Policy on Human medications for details.

EQUESTRIAN CANADA, the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. EQUESTRIAN CANADA is committed to:

Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, is a primary consideration in all activities. Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment. Ensuring that owner, trainer, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose. Providing for the continuous wellbeing of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure. Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare. Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices. Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions. Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses. The standard by which conduct, or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane. All participants at The Classics competitions are expected to abide by this Statement of Principle.

Please note the following when completing your entry forms.

**** As per Article A801 the person responsible for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares, responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC rules and is liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violation of the EC Rules. For the purposes of these Rules, the Person Responsible is normally the trainer, owner or competitor who rides or drives the horse during an event, or a parent or legal guardian in the case of junior competitors. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed in the stables by himself or herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised. The Person Responsible must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. However, when the competitor is a Junior, the competitor cannot be the Person Responsible and the Person Responsible may be a parent/guardian who must be at minimum an EC or USEF member in good standing. The Entry Form must list the Person responsible' name, their EC or USEF member number and must be signed.**

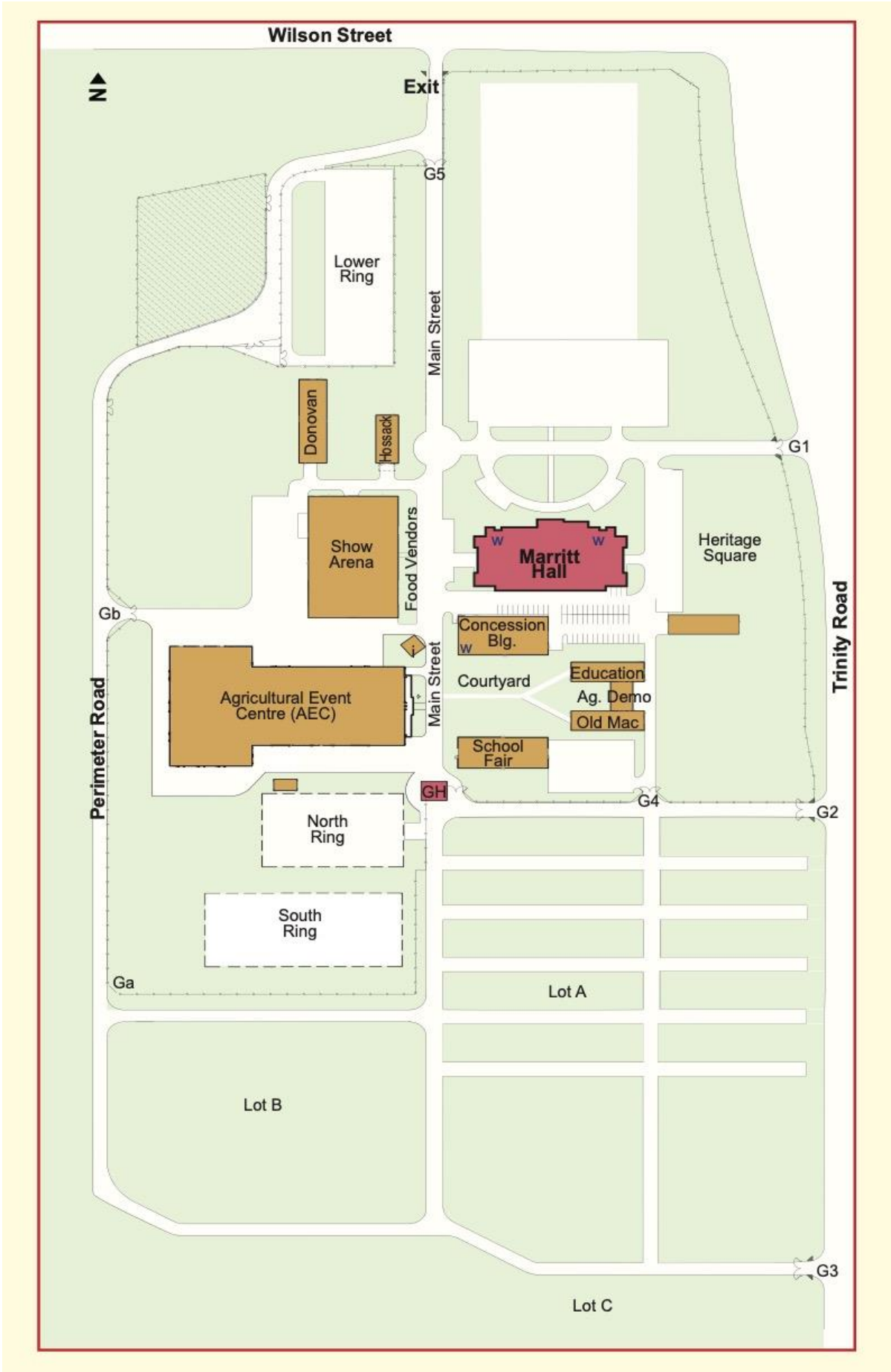
